Pursuant to Article 4, paragraph (1) of the Rulebook on Procedures for Implementing the Small Business Development Program ("Official Gazette of Sarajevo Canton", No. 17/25 and 18/26), and in accordance with the Decision on the Adoption of the Annual Implementation Plan of the Small Business Development Program for 2026, No. 02-04-22645-35/26 of April 30, 2026, adopted at the 126th session of the Government of Sarajevo Canton held on April 30, 2026, the Ministry of Economy of Sarajevo Canton hereby announces:

PUBLIC CALL

for the submission of applications under the program:

**"Incentive for Foreign Direct Investments – Support for the Establishment of a Legal Entity
Whose Founder is a Foreign Investor"**

I. SUBJECT OF THE CALL

The purpose of this Public Call is to award financial support for the establishment of a legal entity – a limited liability company (LLC) headquartered in Sarajevo Canton, whose majority founder is a foreign legal entity without registered business operations in Bosnia and Herzegovina and financial support for small business entities – limited liability companies headquartered in Sarajevo Canton, registered between January 1, 2026, and the date of submission of the application for this Public Call, which have a majority share held by a foreign investor, in accordance with this Public Call.

For participation in this Public Call, the above-mentioned legal entities must meet the criteria for classification as a **small business entity** according to the definition of small business entities in this Chapter, i.e., according to the definition of small business entities from the Law on Encouraging the Development of Small Businesses ("Official Gazette of Sarajevo Canton", No. 29/15) (hereinafter: the Law), as follows:

Definition of Small Business Entities

Small businesses consist of small business entities, natural and legal persons, who permanently engage in legally permitted activities to generate income or profit, including self-employment and family businesses related to trade and other activities, registered with the competent authority, regardless of their organizational form, and which:

- a. Operate independently;
- b. Employ on average fewer than 250 persons annually; and
- c. Have an annual revenue of less than BAM 97,500,000.00 and/or a balance sheet total of less than BAM 84,000,000.00.

Independence in business operations exists if:



- a) Other natural or legal persons who do not meet the criteria for classification as small business entities, individually or collectively, are not owners of capital or do not participate in decision-making rights exceeding 25% in the small business entity.
- b) If the 25% share is exceeded, provided that the ownership or decision-making share in the small business entity is held by an investment fund or the public sector, on the condition that their share of capital or decision-making rights, individually or collectively, does not exceed 50%; and
- c) If the ownership share distribution of the small business entity cannot be determined, and based on a special declaration from the entity, it can be reasonably assumed that other natural or legal persons referred to in points a) and b) of this definition of independence in business operations do not exceed the limitations of independence in business operations of small business entities as specified in points a) and b) of this definition.

III. ELIGIBILITY FOR PARTICIPATION

Under this Public Call, a foreign legal entity that does not have registered operations in Bosnia and Herzegovina, has been operating for at least two years as of December 31, 2025, possesses written proof issued by a bank regarding the status/method of securing its own and/or credit funds required to implement the business plan, meets the criteria for classification as a small business entity as prescribed by Article 3 of the Law (hereinafter referred to as: foreign investor), and has a viable business idea developed through a comprehensive business planning process into a prospective business model presented in the form of a business plan, is eligible to participate.

Also eligible to participate in the Public Call is a small business entity headquartered in Sarajevo Canton that was registered between January 1, 2026, and the date of submission of the application for this Public Call, has a majority foreign investor share as defined in this program, and has a viable business idea developed through a comprehensive business planning process into a prospective business model presented in the form of a business plan (hereinafter referred to as: small business entity).

IV. AMOUNT OF FUNDS

Total planned amount (limit): The total planned amount of funds (limit) for incentives for eligible expenses under this Public Call is **BAM 300,000.00**. These funds are allocated in the Budget of Sarajevo Canton for 2026 under the position "Incentive for Small Business Development," economic code 614500, sub-analytical IAP 005, and are planned in the Annual Implementation Plan of the Small Business Development Program for 2026, No. 02-04-22645-35.1/26 of April 30, 2026 (hereinafter: Annual Plan).

Maximum amount of incentive funds per individual beneficiary: The maximum amount of incentive funds per individual beneficiary is BAM 100,000.00 for eligible costs listed in Chapter V of this Public Call.

V. ELIGIBLE AND INELIGIBLE COSTS

Eligible costs for incentives under this Public Call are costs directly and/or indirectly necessary for performing the core activities of a legal entity with a majority foreign investor share, and relate to:

1. Purchase of machinery, tools, equipment, and technology that is not older than ten years;
2. Business digitalization (including costs of developing an integrated information system, web hosting, business email hosting, corporate informational websites, webshop platform development, mobile application development, etc.); and
3. Strengthening competitiveness through the introduction of international quality standards, i.e., engagement of registered institutions to provide relevant consultancy services and training for system certification and product certification (CE marking) and obtaining or renewing the use of: ISO, HACCP, HALAL, and other international standards.

Note 1: For procurement items listed in points 1), 2), and 3) of this Chapter, the supplier must be a business entity that is registered and operates in accordance with legal regulations.

Note 2: Incentive funds may only be used by a newly established legal entity headquartered in Sarajevo Canton in which the majority share is held by the applicant – the foreign investor selected as a beneficiary of the funds under this Public Call – and solely for eligible costs incurred and paid after the publication of the Notice of this Public Call in the “Official Gazette of Sarajevo Canton.”

Incentive funds for eligible costs may also be used by a selected, already registered small business entity with a majority foreign investor share headquartered in Sarajevo Canton, but again only for eligible costs incurred and paid after the publication of the Notice of this Public Call in the “Official Gazette of Sarajevo Canton.”

Ineligible costs: Purchase of land, apartments/houses, external construction works, and the purchase or lease of any type of motor vehicle, except for the purchase of trucks and work machines registered to the beneficiary of the funds; external construction works; electricity, water, and other utility costs; raw materials; purchase of mobile phones; and all other costs not listed as eligible.

VI. RULES FOR PARTICIPATION – LEGAL ENTITY / FOREIGN INVESTOR

A foreign legal entity without registered operations in Bosnia and Herzegovina (foreign investor) is eligible to participate in the allocation process for incentive funds under this Public Call if it submits an application and:

1. Has been operating for at least two years as of December 31, 2025;
2. Meets the criteria for classification as a small business entity according to the definition in Chapter I of this Public Call, or according to the definition in the Law;
3. Has a viable business idea developed through a comprehensive planning process into a prospective business model presented in the form of a business plan;
4. Has prepared a business plan that necessarily includes total funds required for the implementation of the business plan, as well as secured own and/or credit funds and incentive grant funds for its implementation;
5. Has not allocated incentive grant funds for ineligible costs listed in Chapter V of this Public Call;
6. Has not, by the date of submission, used incentive grant funds from other sources for the same purpose;
7. Is willing to register a legal entity – a limited liability company headquartered in Sarajevo Canton, in which it holds the majority share, if selected as a beneficiary of funds under this Public Call;
8. Is willing to ensure that the legal entity referred to in point 7 of this Chapter provides an unconditional, on-demand bank guarantee for proper execution of the incentive funds agreement under this Public Call in the amount of approved funds, increased by contractual penalties and applicable statutory interest, before signing the agreement (the cost of the bank guarantee shall be borne by the beneficiary, and the cost is considered an eligible expense as part of the beneficiary’s own contribution);
9. Possesses written proof issued by a bank regarding the method/status of securing own and/or credit funds required to implement the business plan referred to in point 4 of this Chapter;
10. Is willing to provide a cash contribution in the share capital of the legal entity referred to in point 7 of this Chapter of at least 40% of the total requested amount of incentive grant funds under this Public Call, and to use at least this amount for the implementation of the business plan referred to in point 4 of this Chapter;
11. Ensures that its business idea (developed in the business plan) is an activity that can be identified and registered as the primary activity of a business entity according to the activity



classification BiH NACE 2010 (“Official Gazette of BiH”, No. 47/10) listed in Table 1, Chapter II of this Public Call, except for activities subject to restrictions under Article 3 of the Law on Foreign Investments of the Federation of BiH (“Official Gazette of the Federation of BiH”, Nos. 61/01, 50/03, and 77/15);

12. Has submitted the application in accordance with this Public Call;

13. Meets all other requirements of this Public Call; and

14. Is selected as a beneficiary of funds based on the application of the selection criteria in Chapter X of this Public Call and the total planned fund limits in Chapter IV of this Public Call.

For the applicant – foreign investor, this Public Call is implemented in **two phases** as follows:

VI.1 Phase I of the Public Call

In the first phase of this Public Call, the applicant – foreign investor, when applying, is required to submit:

1. **Application form**, in original, duly completed in one of the official languages of Bosnia and Herzegovina, certified by the signature of the authorized person of the applicant and stamped with the applicant’s seal if, according to the law of the country where the applicant is headquartered, the applicant is required to have a seal. If the applicant is not legally required to have a seal, proof of this exemption must be provided.
2. **Certificates and documentation**, as follows:
 - a) Current extract from the company register for the foreign legal entity – applicant, not older than 90 days from the date of publication of the Notice of the Public Call in the “**Official Gazette of Sarajevo Canton**”, additionally certified with an **Apostille stamp** (original);
 - b) Translation of the extract referred to in point a) into one of the official languages of Bosnia and Herzegovina, certified by an authorized court interpreter for that language, and additionally certified with an Apostille stamp. If the official translation is certified by an authorized court interpreter within the territory of Bosnia and Herzegovina, no Apostille certification is required (original);
 - c) **Business plan**, certified by the applicant as prescribed in point 1) of this Chapter, prepared in one of the official languages of Bosnia and Herzegovina, compliant with economic standards and the content requirements from Chapter X, Table 2 of this Public Call (original);
 - d) Written proof issued by the applicant’s bank regarding the method/status of securing own and/or credit funds necessary to implement the business plan referred to in Chapter VI, point 4) of this Public Call, not older than 30 days from the date of publication of the Notice of the Public Call in the “**Official Gazette of Sarajevo Canton**” (original);
 - e) Translation of the written proof referred to in point d) into one of the official languages of Bosnia and Herzegovina, certified by an authorized court interpreter for that language (original);
 - f) **Declaration of the applicant** in original (Annex 1 of the Public Call), prepared in one of the official languages of Bosnia and Herzegovina and certified by the applicant as prescribed in point 1) of this Chapter, in which the applicant, under full moral, material, and criminal responsibility, confirms:
 - i. That it does not have registered operations in Bosnia and Herzegovina;
 - ii. That no criminal proceedings are pending against the applicant and that it has not been legally convicted for a criminal offense and/or economic offense;
 - iii. That it has been operating for at least two years as of December 31, 2025;
 - iv. That it has no outstanding unpaid obligations for taxes, contributions, or other public charges in accordance with the laws of the country of registration;
 - v. That no bankruptcy, liquidation, or other appropriate proceedings have been initiated against the applicant in accordance with the laws of the country of registration;
 - vi. That it meets the criteria for classification as a small business entity according to the definition in the **Law on Encouraging the Development of Small Businesses** (“Official Gazette of Sarajevo



·Canton”, No. 29/15);

- vii. That, as of the date of submission, it has not used incentive grant funds from other sources for the same purpose;
- viii. That it is willing to register a legal entity headquartered in Sarajevo Canton in which it holds the majority share if selected as a beneficiary of funds under this Public Call;
- ix. That it is willing to ensure that the legal entity referred to in Chapter VI.1, point 2), subpoint f) viii. of this Public Call provides an **unconditional, on-demand bank guarantee** for proper execution of the agreement in the amount of approved funds, increased by contractual penalties and applicable statutory interest, prior to signing the grant agreement;
- x. That it is willing to provide a **cash contribution** in the share capital of the legal entity referred to in Chapter VI, point 10) of this Public Call of at least 40% of the total requested incentive grant funds, and that it is ready to use at least this amount for the implementation of the business plan referred to in Chapter VI, point 4) of this Public Call;
- xi. That all data and documentation submitted under this Public Call are true;
- xii. That it agrees for the results of this Public Call to be published on the website of the **Ministry of Economy of Sarajevo Canton**; and
- xiii. That it agrees that the **Ministry of Economy of Sarajevo Canton** and the Committee for the Selection of Incentive Fund Beneficiaries under this Public Call may process documents proving the personal identity of persons related to this application in accordance with the provisions of the **Personal Data Protection Law** (“Official Gazette of BiH”, No. 12/25).

Note 1: An applicant whose headquarters is located in a country that is a signatory to the Convention Abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Documents of 1961 (hereinafter: Hague Convention) shall certify the documents referred to in Chapter VI, point 2), subpoints a) and b) with an Apostille stamp. An applicant whose headquarters is in a country that is not a signatory of the Hague Convention shall carry out full (regular) legalization of these documents. An applicant whose headquarters is located in a country with which Bosnia and Herzegovina has a bilateral agreement on recognition of public documents without legalization is not required to provide additional certification of these documents.

Note 2: An applicant whose headquarters is located in a country where one of the official languages of Bosnia and Herzegovina is in official use is not required to provide an official translation of the documents referred to in Chapter VI, point 2), subpoints b) and e); the applicant may submit the original or a certified copy of these documents.

VI.2 Phase II of the Public Call

In the second phase of this Public Call, the newly established legal entity with a majority share held by the applicant, selected by decision of the Government of Sarajevo Canton (hereinafter: newly established legal entity), is required, prior to signing the grant agreement, to submit:

1. Certificates and other documentation of the newly established legal entity, as follows:

- a) Current extract from the court register for the entity, issued by the Municipal Court in Sarajevo, showing the registered majority share held by the selected applicant and the minimum cash contribution of this share of 40% of the requested incentive grant funds under this Public Call (original or copy certified by a competent authority – municipality/notary);
- b) Bank confirmation of the executed payment order showing the transfer of the minimum amount referred to in subpoint a) (original);
- c) Tax registration certificate – identification number (ID) issued by the Tax Administration of the Federation of BiH (original or copy certified by a competent authority – municipality/notary);

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- d) Certificate from the Municipal Court in Sarajevo demonstrating that no indictments have been filed against the applicant (legal entity/business entity) in the courts of Bosnia and Herzegovina that have become legally binding, nor have any indictments been confirmed, and that no conviction has been pronounced for a criminal offense with a prescribed prison sentence of up to five years or a fine as the main penalty (original or copy certified by a competent authority – municipality/notary);
- e) Notice of classification of the newly established legal entity according to the primary activity classification, issued by the Federal Office of Statistics – Statistical Service for the Sarajevo Canton area, according to the Activity Classification BiH NACE 2010 (“Official Gazette of BiH”, No. 47/10) (original or copy certified by a competent authority – municipality/notary);
- f) List of insured employees for the taxpayer – newly established legal entity, issued by the Tax Administration of the Federation of BiH, not older than 30 days from the date of submission, showing at least two employees (original or copy certified by a competent authority – municipality/notary);
- g) Agreement or bank confirmation of the opened main bank account in the name of the newly established legal entity (original or copy certified by a competent authority – municipality/notary);
- h) Unconditional, on-demand bank guarantee for proper execution of the agreement, in the amount of approved incentive funds, increased by contractual penalties and statutory interest, with the amount and validity period of the guarantee determined by the decision on the allocation of funds under this Public Call (original);
- i) Declaration of the authorized person of the newly established legal entity (Annex 2 of the Public Call), in original, prepared in one of the official languages of Bosnia and Herzegovina, certified by the signature of the authorized person, and additionally certified by a competent authority – municipality/notary, in which the authorized person, under full moral, material, and criminal responsibility, confirms:
- i. That the newly established legal entity will purposefully use the funds granted under this Public Call;
- ii. That the applicant and the newly established legal entity have not received incentive grant funds through other financing/co-financing programs for the subject of the grant for which the application was submitted under this Public Call;
- iii. That the newly established business entity will co-finance the implementation of the business plan submitted under this Public Call with at least 40% of the requested incentive grant funds;
- iv. That all data and documentation submitted by the newly established legal entity under this Public Call are true;
- v. That it agrees that the Ministry of Economy of Sarajevo Canton may process documents proving its personal identity and the personal identity of other persons related to this application, in accordance with the Personal Data Protection Law (“Official Gazette of BiH”, No. 12/25); and
- vi. That the applicant and/or the responsible person in the applicant and/or the owner/founder of the applicant is not in a conflict of interest under the Law on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption in Sarajevo Canton (“Official Gazette of Sarajevo Canton”, No. 35/22, 44/22, and 55/22) in the event of signing the grant agreement based on this Public Call.

Special Notes:

- An applicant selected by decision of the Government of Sarajevo Canton, prior to signing the grant agreement, is obliged to register the newly established legal entity, i.e., a limited liability company in which they hold a majority share, and to submit the complete documentation referred to in Chapter VI.2 of this Public Call to the Ministry of Economy of Sarajevo Canton. The grant agreement will define all details and rules for the use of the incentive funds (rights and obligations of the contracting parties).



- The funds recipient – newly established legal entity is obliged to operate for a minimum of two years from the date of its registration, and during this period, it is not allowed to dispose of or sell fixed assets financed by the incentive funds allocated under this Public Call.
- The final deadline for signing the agreement with the newly established legal entity (funds recipient), which submits documentation under Chapter VI.2 of this Public Call to the Ministry of Economy of Sarajevo Canton by 30 November 2026, is 31 December 2026.
- In accordance with Article 8, paragraph (3) of the Rules on Procedures for Implementing the Small Business Development Program (“Official Gazette of Sarajevo Canton”, No. 17/25), documentation submitted under the Public Call will not be returned to the applicant.
- If it is subsequently determined that the statements in the declaration from Chapter VI.1, point f) and Chapter VI.2, point i) are false, or that any other documentation submitted by the applicant and the newly established legal entity, as required by this Public Call, is false, the application will not be considered. Furthermore, if such facts are discovered after the allocation of incentive funds, the newly established legal entity that received the funds is obliged to return the funds along with the applicable statutory interest.

VII. PARTICIPATION RULES FOR REGISTERED SMALL BUSINESS ENTITIES

The right to participate in the process of allocating incentive funds under this Public Call is granted to a registered small business entity if it:

1. Has its registered office in the Sarajevo Canton;
2. Is registered between 1 January 2026 and the date of submitting the application to this Public Call;
3. Is majority-owned by a foreign investor – legal entity that:
 - a) Has been operating for at least two years as of 31 December 2025;
 - b) Meets the criteria for classification as a small business entity according to the definition of small business entities in Chapter I of this Public Call, or according to the definition in the Law;
 - c) Has provided a capital contribution to the registered entity – applicant, amounting to at least 40% of the total requested incentive grant funds under this Public Call;
4. Is ready to provide an unconditional and first-demand bank guarantee for the proper execution of the grant agreement under this Public Call in the amount of approved funds, increased by contractual penalties and applicable statutory interest, prior to signing the grant agreement (Costs of securing the bank guarantee are borne by the funds recipient, and the cost is considered an eligible cost as part of the recipient’s own contribution);
5. Is ready to use at least 40% of the total requested incentive grant funds under this Public Call for the implementation of the business plan referred to in point 8 of this Chapter;
6. Employs at least two full-time employees;
7. Has a quality business idea, developed through a comprehensive planning process into a viable business model presented in the form of a business plan;
8. Has prepared a business plan in accordance with economic standards, which must include total funds required for implementing the business plan, as well as secured own funds and/or credit funds and incentive grant funds for its implementation;
9. Has not included the use of incentive funds for ineligible costs listed in Chapter V of this Public Call;



10. Has not used incentive funds from other sources for the same purpose prior to submitting the application;
11. Has a business idea (formulated and developed in the business plan) that can be identified and registered as the primary activity of the business entity according to the KD BiH 2010 activity classification ("Official Gazette of BiH", No. 47/10) from Chapter II, Table 1 of this Public Call;
12. Is registered to carry out the primary activity listed in Chapter II of this Public Call;
13. Has submitted the application in accordance with this Public Call;
14. Meets all other requirements of this Public Call; and
15. Is selected as a funds recipient based on the selection criteria in Chapter X, Table 3 of this Public Call and the total funding limit in Chapter IV.

For the applicant – small business entity, this Public Call is conducted in two phases, as follows:

VII.1 Phase I of the Public Call Implementation

In Phase I of this Public Call, the applicant (already registered legal entity) is required, when applying, to submit:

1. Application form, fully completed, signed by the authorized person, and sealed with the applicant's stamp;
2. Documents and supporting materials, as follows:
 - a) Current extract from the court register for the applicant entity, not older than 90 days from the date of publication of the Public Call Notice in the "Official Gazette of Sarajevo Canton," issued by the Municipal Court in Sarajevo, showing the majority share held by the foreign investor as specified in sub-point c) of this item and the minimum monetary amount of this share equal to 40% of the requested incentive grant funds under this Public Call (original or copy certified by the competent authority – municipality/notary);
 - b) Bank confirmation of payment order, evidencing that the foreign investor from sub-point c) of this item has deposited the minimum amount specified in sub-point a) of this item (original);
 - c) Current extract from the companies register for the foreign investor – legal entity holding the majority ownership of the applicant, not older than 90 days from the date of publication of the Public Call Notice in the "Official Gazette of Sarajevo Canton," duly certified with an Apostille (original);
 - d) Translation of the extract from sub-point c) of this item into one of the official languages of BiH, certified by an authorized court interpreter for that language and additionally certified with an Apostille. If the official translation is certified by an authorized court interpreter in BiH, an additional Apostille certification is not required (original);
 - e) Written bank confirmation issued by the applicant's bank regarding the status of securing own and/or credit funds necessary for the implementation of the business plan referred to in Chapter VII, point 8 of this Public Call, not older than 30 days from the date of publication of the Public Call Notice in the "Official Gazette of Sarajevo Canton" (original);
 - j) Certificate from the Municipal Court in Sarajevo demonstrating that no indictment with legal effect has been filed against the applicant (legal entity/business entity) before any courts in Bosnia and Herzegovina, and that no conviction has been issued for a criminal offense punishable by imprisonment of up to five years or a fine as the main penalty (original or copy certified by the competent authority – municipality/notary).
- f) Certificate confirming that the applicant is not under bankruptcy proceedings nor subject to liquidation, not older than 30 days from the date of publication of the Public Call Notice in the



“Official Gazette of Sarajevo Canton,” issued by the Municipal Court in Sarajevo (original or copy certified by the competent authority – municipality/notary);

g) Certificate of taxpayer registration (applicant), issued by the Tax Administration of the Federation of BiH – Cantonal Tax Office Sarajevo (original or copy certified by the competent authority – municipality/notary);

h) Certificate of VAT registration issued by the Indirect Taxation Authority of BiH, or, if the applicant is not a VAT payer, a certificate from the Indirect Taxation Authority of BiH confirming that the applicant is not registered in the Unified Register of Indirect Taxpayers, not older than 90 days from the date of publication of the Public Call Notice in the “Official Gazette of Sarajevo Canton” (original or copy certified by the competent authority – municipality/notary);

i) Notification of classification of the applicant according to the classification of main activity, issued by the Federal Office of Statistics – Statistics Service for the Sarajevo Canton area, according to the KD BiH 2010 Classification of Activities (“Official Gazette of BiH,” No. 47/10) (original or copy certified by the competent authority – municipality/notary);

j) Certificate from the Tax Administration of the Federation of BiH confirming that the applicant has settled tax and contribution obligations, with the mandatory attachment – list of insured persons for the taxpayer, not older than 30 days from the date of publication of the Public Call Notice in the “Official Gazette of Sarajevo Canton” (original or copy certified by the competent authority – municipality/notary);

k) Certificate from the Indirect Taxation Authority of BiH confirming the settlement of indirect taxes, not older than 30 days from the date of publication of the Public Call Notice in the “Official Gazette of Sarajevo Canton” (original or copy certified by the competent authority – municipality/notary), except if the applicant submitted a certificate from the Indirect Taxation Authority of BiH that it is not registered in the Unified Register of Indirect Taxpayers under sub-point h) of this item;

l) Business plan, certified by the signature of the authorized person and the applicant’s stamp, prepared in accordance with economic standards and the content from Chapter X, Table 2 of this Public Call (original);

m) Contract or bank confirmation of an open bank account in the name of the applicant (original or copy certified by the competent authority – municipality/notary);

n) Declaration of the authorized person of the applicant, in original (Annex 3 of the Public Call), certified by the signature of the authorized person and additionally certified by the competent authority – municipality/notary, in which the authorized person, under full moral, material, and criminal responsibility, confirms:

i. That, up to the date of submission of the application for this Public Call, neither the applicant in which the authorized person is involved, nor the majority owner/founder of the applicant, have used incentive funds originating from the Budget of Sarajevo Canton and/or the budgets of local self-government units, the Public Institution “Employment Service of Sarajevo Canton,” the Federal Employment Service, or donor organizations for the same activities from the business plan of the selected applicant, nor have they concluded any grant award agreements from the aforementioned sources;

ii. Special Notes:

- The applicant (small business entity) selected by the decision of the Government of the Sarajevo Canton, before signing the grant agreement, is obliged to submit all documentation from Chapter VII.2 of this Public Call to the Ministry of Economy of the Sarajevo Canton. The grant agreement will define all details and rules for the use of the granted funds (rights and obligations of the contracting parties).
- The fund recipient is obliged to operate for a minimum of two years, starting from the date of disbursement of the grant funds, and during this period it is not allowed to dispose of the fixed assets financed by the grant funds provided under this Public Call.
- The final deadline for signing the agreement with the selected applicant (small business entity) who submits the documentation from Chapter VII.2 of this Public Call to the Ministry of Economy of the Sarajevo Canton by 30.11.2026 is 31.12.2026.

If these facts are discovered after the disbursement of grant funds, the legal entity that received the funds is obliged to return these funds with the applicable statutory interest.

2. Applications shall also be scored according to the criterion of the total co-financing amount for the implementation of the business plan, and the highest value under this criterion expressed in convertible marks shall be awarded 30 points.
3. For an applicant offering a co-financing amount lower than the highest value referred to in item 2) of this Section, the scoring shall be carried out as follows:
(Total value of the business plan co-financing amount / Highest value of the business plan co-financing amount) x 30 points.
4. Based on the criteria referred to in items 1) and 2) of this Section, the applicant may obtain a maximum of 100 points.

XI OTHER PROVISIONS

The Ministry of Economy of Sarajevo Canton undertakes to supervise the implementation of the contractual obligations arising from the agreement on the allocation of incentive funds by inspecting documentation at its own premises and at the premises of the beneficiary, and, if necessary, by



inspecting data obtained officially from the relevant competent authority. While conducting supervision, the Ministry of Economy of Sarajevo Canton shall undertake measures within its competence, and in cases where it factually establishes grounds for undertaking the relevant measure or establishes the existence of grounds for suspicion of criminal liability of a certain person in their actions before and after the conclusion of the agreement, the Ministry of Economy of Sarajevo Canton shall, without delay, initiate proceedings to determine the criminal liability of that person.

In order to protect their rights, an applicant under this Public Call may submit a written objection to the Ministry of Economy of Sarajevo Canton within eight days from the date of publication of the preliminary proposal of beneficiaries of incentive funds. The Ministry of Economy of Sarajevo Canton shall decide on such objection no later than within 30 working days.
